## High-Quality Wood

### Remnants:

- Craft an elegant coffee table or a set of nesting tables, finishing them with a high-gloss lacquer or stain.
- Design a bespoke headboard for the bedroom, incorporating velvet upholstery or intricate carvings.
- Create a statement piece of wall art by assembling wood pieces into a herringbone or chevron pattern and adding a gold or silver leaf finish.

## Luxury Fabric Scraps:

- Sew together pieces of high-end fabric remnants, such as silk, velvet, or leather, to make luxurious cushion covers or chic throw blankets.
- Upholster a vintage chair or ottoman in a patchwork of leftover designer fabrics.
- Frame smaller pieces of exquisite textiles, like those from designer samples or fashion garments, to create sophisticated wall art.



## Glass and Crystal:

- Transform crystal decanters or wine bottles into elegant lamp bases.
- Use etched glass panels to create a custom room divider or a decorative window.
- Design unique lighting fixtures using clusters of glass jars or bottles, incorporating high-quality metals for the fixtures.

## Ceramic and Porcelain Tiles:

- Use leftover luxury tiles to create a decorative mirror frame or tabletop.
- Install a mosaic of fine porcelain tiles on a bathroom wall or as a kitchen island front.
- Craft an upscale serving tray with a tile base, adding brass or chrome handles for a refined touch.



## Metal Scraps:

- Weld together pieces of metal to create a sculptural artwork or a luxury floor lamp.
- Refashion metal remnants into a modern fireplace screen or decorative room accents with polished finishes.
- Design a high-end wine rack or a set of shelves with a brushed or aged metal finish.

## Leftover Natural Stone:

- Use marble or granite scraps to fabricate bespoke coasters, cutting boards, or a bathroom vanity top.
- Create an elegant garden bench or an outdoor sculpture using larger pieces of stone.
- Assemble a luxury backsplash or a foyer floor inlay from various stone remnants.
